



Tint Coating v. Traditional Staining

Traditional staining saturates the wood with pigment while tint coating combines color and finish on top of the wood in a single step, saving labor, lightly changing the hue or color of the wood floor.

TINT COATING PROCESS

STEP 1

Apply a clear sealer



STEP 2

Mix HyperTone™ Stains with finish



STEP 3

Test on a sample piece



STEP 4

Adjust ratio of stain to achieve desired color



STEP 5

Apply thin and even layers



STEP 6

Protect with a non-yellowing finish
