



## TINT COATING

Tint coating is a process in which stain is mixed into a finish and applied directly to a pre-sealed wood floor. This method creates a subtle layer of color that builds color and enhances the natural wood grain, providing a seamless, customizable, and even look.

## Tint Coating v. Traditional Staining

Traditional staining saturates the wood with pigment while tint coating combines color and finish on top of the wood in a single step, saving labor, lightly changing the hue or color of the wood floor.

### TINT COATING PROCESS

#### STEP 1

Apply a clear sealer



#### STEP 2

Mix HyperTone™ Stains with finish



#### STEP 3

Test on a sample piece



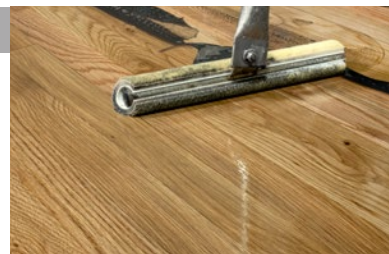
#### STEP 4

Adjust ratio of stain to achieve desired color



#### STEP 5

Apply thin and even layers



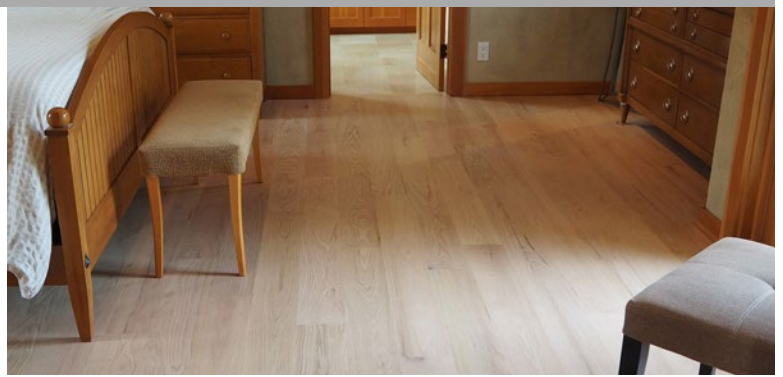
#### STEP 6
